Chairperson and Director's Report

Bibliothèque Montcalm Library continues to maintain excellent partnerships with several organizations within the community. The library, which is located in École régionale Saint-Jean Baptiste, benefits from a multitude of services provided by the **Division scolaire franco-manitobaine**. The Centre de la petite enfance and the daycare, Étoiles d'la Rouge, are always welcome to visit the library and have access to all its services.

For its seventh year in a row, the library participated in the **TD Summer Reading Program.** Activities included crafts relating to the theme...*here we go!* Participants could also earn prizes for having answered questions pertaining to the story that he or she had read.

This summer, the library remained closed for approximately 4 weeks due to renovations because the roof had leaked! The ceiling tiles were replaced and the carpet was removed and replaced with vinyl flooring. Luckily, no books were damaged.

We wish to thank the **Province of Manitoba Culture, Heritage and Tourism** and the **Rural Municipality of Montcalm** for their continued financial support. We would also like to thank all levels of government and **Canada Post** for keeping interlibrary postal rates affordable.

The Rural Municipality of Montcalm has three population centers: Saint-Joseph, Letellier and Saint-Jean-Baptiste with a total population of 1 309.

Services

Residents from the Rural Municipality of Montcalm can benefit from multiple services that the library has to offer. Come see over 20 000 articles in French and in English comprising of books, magazines, DVDs, videocassettes, and compact discs. Children, teens and adults can find multiple treasures to meet their needs.

Reciprocal borrowing agreement

The Rural Municipality of Montcalm and the South Central Regional Library (SCRL) have a reciprocal borrowing agreement allowing residents from both regions to borrow from each other's libraries. Montcalm residents must show their Bibliothèque Montcalm library card when borrowing from a SCRL in Altona, Winkler or Morden.

Library cards can be obtained free of charge from the library.

Small library at the Paradis des Pionniers

Bibliothèque Montcalm Library offers library services to our manor, the Paradis des Pionniers. The library delivers a variety of books, magazines, and DVDs. The rotation is done every seven weeks.

Summer Reading Program

The TD Summer Reading Club is designed to motivate your children to develop and improve their reading skills throughout the summer by various fun-filled incentives and activities. When children register at the library for this **free** program, they receive an exciting reading kit comprising a poster, stickers and an activity logbook all sponsored by the Toronto Dominion Bank, the Toronto Public Library and Library and Archives Canada. Interlibrary loans

If we do not have the book that you are looking for, it is possible to request it from another library using the interlibrary loan service. Once the request has been sent, the book is generally received within a week. You may also do your own search by logging on to <u>https://fill.mb.libraries.coop</u>.

The **Fédération des bibliothèques des municipalités bilingues (FBMB)** is an organization which helps to promote the French language by allowing their libraries to purchase French DVDs through the financial support from the **Association of Manitoba Bilingual Municipalities**. The library has nine computers with high speed internet available to the public. The computers have a variety of programs including Word, Excel, Power Point and Publisher. Copies may be printed for 20¢ per copy. There is a resource person on site to help when needed.
